



BH&M were commissioned to design a new indoor pool for Maltman's Green School to replace their ageing existing outdoor facility. The new pool is 6 lanes wide and 25m in length ranging from 1.2 metres to 2 metres deep which enables the school to host National galas. The facility also boasts a first floor viewing gallery around three sides of the pool along with a large multi-purpose room used for seminars, teaching and functions. There are two well-equipped changing rooms with private showers and underfloor heating.

The building was designed to sit comfortably next to several quaint traditional buildings by picking up the detail band in the brickwork and introducing brick arch gateways linked back to the existing buildings. The project started on site in August 2003 and was completed in 2004.
